Funded by Public Safety Canada, the RCIY Project - associated with San Romanoway Revitalization Association - serves Black and racialized youth, 12-29 years old, deemed "atrisk." Through direct services, the aim is to provide participants with support, tools and opportunities to foster improved lifestyles and relationships, and positive community engagement in their everyday lives.

RCIY SERVICES

WORKSHOPS

This 12- part workshop series focuses on community-specific and relevant topics such as: life skills, employment, guns, and gang violence, healthy relationships, etc.

EDUCATION ATTAINMENT AND SUPPORT

Our academic interventions are tailored to youth aged 12-29 years who are out of school, on probation, in school (but in need of extra support), upgrading for postsecondary/employment, and looking to achieving their OSSGD, GED, or high school credits.



COUNSELLING

Family Support Workers provide one-on-one, and group/family counselling to youth and their families in need of assistance during compounding challenges and circumstances.

CASE-MANAGEMENT

Family Support/Youth Outreach Workers conduct intake assessments and establish personalized interventions tailored to each participant.

CAPACITY BUILDING

Family Support/Youth Outreach Workers liaise with Employment and Training Sectors to provide trainings appropriate to build and develop skills towards employment, apprenticeship and other future opportunities.
